Designed to easily fold up, fitting into most car trunks and is meant to be transported for wherever you need to be




## **How it Works**

Follow these 6 steps to secure a patient in the chair:

- After making sure the patient is in the correct seating position, open up the seat.
- Push the chair towards the patient, position their feet on the footrests, and lock the wheels.
- Using the remote, adjust the height of the device to match the patient's seating height.
- Close the seat around the patient.
- 5 Secure the double locking assembly in the back, and adjust their seatbelt.
- When you're ready to move the patient, release the wheel locks.

The Freedom Transfer Patient Lift is also equipped with arm grips that the caregiver can use while transporting the patient, or, alternatively, the patient can hold them for stability while being transported.

The Freedom Transfer Patient Lift is easy to use. It's much less cumbersome and labor intensive to use than other types of patient lifts such as Hoyer lifts, as well as safer for both the patient and caregiver. 


